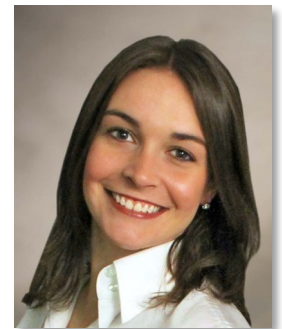
REBECCA BELL-TAYLOR, ABR *First National Realty*
